

GCCG 2009 CYMBIDIUM COLLECTOR'S AUCTION

NOTES:

1) The ID column in the auction table indicates who supplied the plants. Two alphabetic characters (AA) identify the supplier. These are: Gloria Bygdnes (GB), Cal-Orchid, Inc. (CO), Anna Chai (AC), Weegie Caughlan (WC), Greg Corrales (GC), Heather Drobus (HD), Ed Dumaguin (ED), Carole Finnegan (CF), Annie Green (AG), Edie Guidoux (EG), Trudy Hadler (TH), Ken Jacobsen (KJ), Carl Jukkola (CJ), Pat Proctor (PP), Eanghak Quach (EQ), Top Hat Orchids (TO), Darrel Wong (DW), Audrey Young-Tarter (AY), and Barry Zimmerman (BZ).

2) An ID of AANN indicates a sale plant, with the numeric part (NN) used for accounting purposes. An ID of DAA indicates a donated plant. The ID of GCCG identifies plants purchased by the club.

3) The values stated in the description of the plants were determined by the seller and the auction committee for the benefit of the auctioneer and bidders.

4) Some sellers and donors have provided flower pictures of their plants listed in the auction. Pictures submitted at time of publication are noted (picture), but others may be added after publication. If you are interested in browsing the preview photo library, please go to the following link:

5) Labels for all auction plants will be provided to the sellers and donors when the plants are checked in at the auction.

2009 AUCTION RULES:

- 1) Only members may enter sale plants. For the member sale plants that are auctioned, the club retains 25% of the proceeds, and the member will get 75% of the proceeds.
- 2) Donated plants will be accepted from members and non-members. As in the past, all DONATED plants will be virus-tested before the auction.
- 3) All plants must be pre-entered by the stated deadline published in the GCCG January 2009 Newsletter, complete with all known information.
- 4) Auction entries will be limited to 200 items/plants, except that entries from the same seller/donor included in the same plant submission as the 200th plant will be accepted.
- 5) No entries will be accepted after the limit or deadline has been reached, whichever occurs first.
- 6) A member may enter no more than 10 plants for sale.
- 7) A limit of 10 plants per donor is requested.
- 8) It is suggested that all sellers consider donating at least 1-2 plants when entering 10 plants for sale.
- 9) An individual seller/donor may not enter more than two divisions of the same plant in the auction.
- 10) No plants will be allowed into the building the night of the auction unless pre-entered or as a pre-approved substitute for one damaged.
- 11) If a plant carrying a minimum bid does not sell at the minimum bid stated, the seller will still be responsible to the club for 25% of the listed minimum bid. *(OPTION: If the seller so designates to the auction committee in advance, a "reverse auction" may be held on a plant failing to receive the minimum bid.)
- 12) Successful bids and bidders will be tracked on a projector screen. Photos of the plants (if available) will also be projected on a screen as they are presented for auction.
- 13) Bidders are asked not to check out until the last plant is auctioned and the auction concluded. Receipt to bidders will include a printout of their successful bids.
- 14) Payment to sellers and acknowledgement to donors will include a printout of each of their entries with the sales amount.
