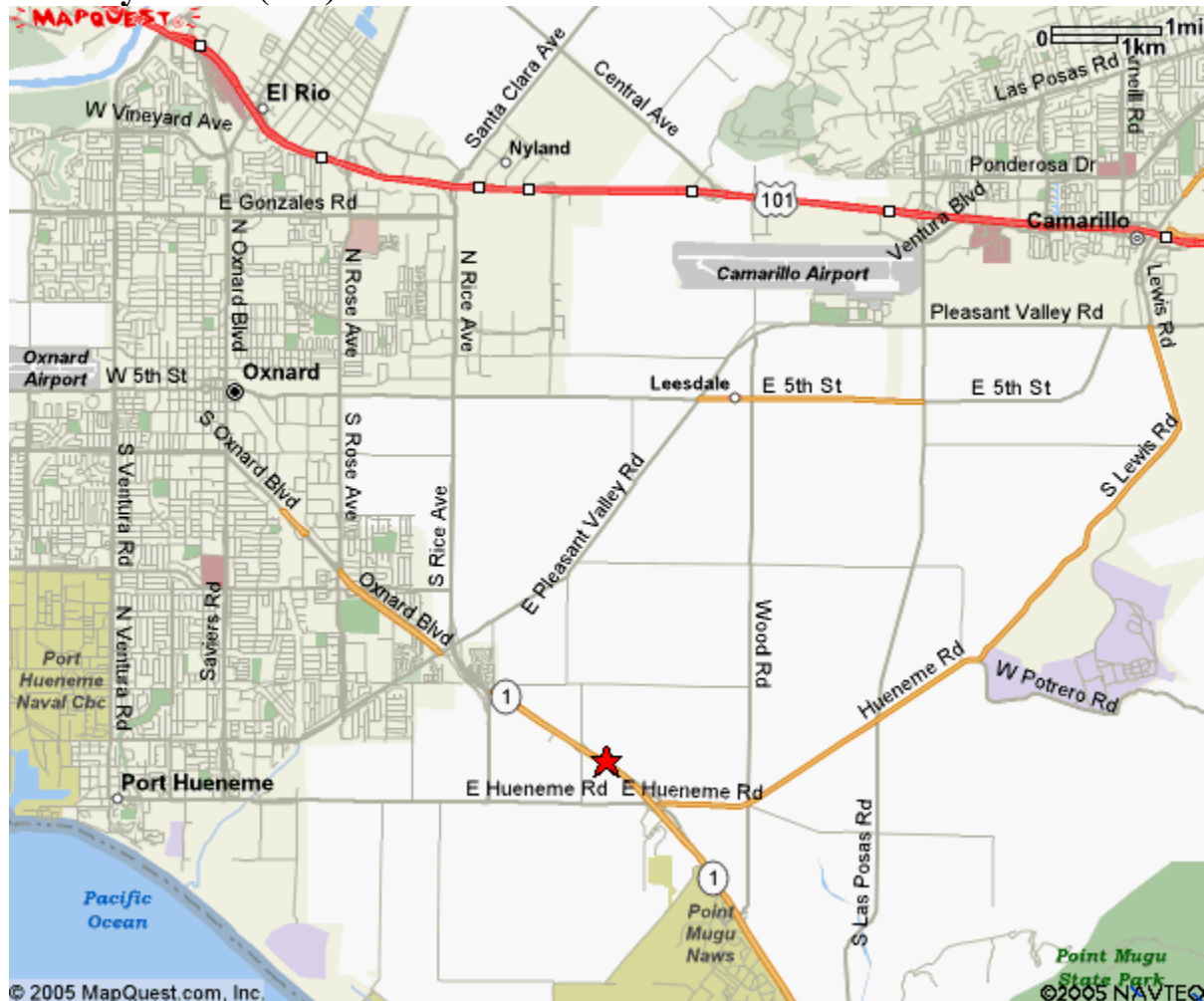

New Seedling release

Howard Cobb 'Plum' 4n x Fifi 'Harry' 4n – These plants should be relatively compact and floriferous. We expect to see unusual plum colored flowers on long pendulous flower spikes. Blooming period should March – May.

Fifi 'Harry' 4n x Mae West 'Geyserland' B/CSA - These plants will be large and robust. We expect bright orange flowers on long pendulous flower spikes. Blooming period should be March – May.

Lillian Fujimoto 'New Horizon' x Ruby Pendant 'Geyserland' - This will be a very interesting cross that should produce many award winners! We expect to see very round red to pink flowers on very long flower spikes. Don't miss this. Flowering season March – May.

Douglass Dillion 'Hatfield's' HCC/AOS x Pink Champagne 'Featherhill' - These will be excellent bright pink Standards! Large flowers upto 5 inches across. Very good growers and truly top quality show plants will come from this cross. Blooming January - February.

Rincon 'Clarisse Austin' 4n x George Formby 'New Horizon' 4n – A true Ripper! Show bench round spotted flowers. We expect these to be very special and very good growers! Awards! Blooming February – March.

Pink Champagne 'Featherhill' X John Wooden 'Geyserland' AM/AOS - Early / Mid season pink standards of extremely high quality! These will be good growing plants of top quality. Awards! Blooming January – March.

Pink Champagne 'Featherhill' X Finger of Suspicion #1 - Show bench spotted flowers. We expect these to be very special and very good growers! Awards! Blooming February – March.

Pink Champagne 'Featherhill' x Lena Bauer 'Hatfield's' 4n - Mid season pink standards of extremely high quality! These will be good growing plants of top quality. Awards! Blooming February – March.

Pendulous:

Moon Dust (Sarah Jean 'Ice Cascade' 4N X Fifi 'Harry' 4N) - Very nice, easy to grow plants. We expect show bench pendant plants with long white to cream colored flowers. This is a must have for all serious growers! April blooming!

Sarah Jean 'Ice Cascade' 4N X lowianum 'Concolor' - White flowers of top quality! These will bloom in April with intermediate flowers of nice form. We expect these to be awarded.

Nancy Miyamoto 'Hatfield's' 4n X canaliculatum 'Alice' - Intermediate pendulous spotted flowers that will be show stoppers. Unlike most Cym. canaliculatum hybrids that grow erratically, these plants are really robust growers. Hi level of warmth tolerance here so these should work for everyone everywhere!

Key Largo 'Ryan Bui' X pumillum var. 'Album' – Intermediate Green arching to pendulous spikes on compact plants that should grow like weeds! This hybrid was made by Ha Bui. We expect some show winners here.

Intermediates:

Sarah Jean 'IC' 4n X insigne 'alba' – Long pendulous spikes of beautiful white flowers. These will be bright white. We expect compact show bench flowers that bloom extremely freely April/May. This hybrid represents a new line of breeding that will grow rapidly and flower without fail.

Falling Passion 'New Horizon' 4n X Golden Tiger '22002' 4n – Intermediate whites that will be prolific bloomers. These plants should bloom February – March.

Blanche Ames 'Lizzy' HCC/AOS X Gordon Gibbs 'Dashing' 4n – Intermediate pendulous reds of outstanding quality. Show type pendulous flowers on plants that have a good deal of warmth tolerance. Don't miss these winners!

Mizuha Okhada 'Geyserland' X Pumillo 'New Horizon' 4n - Intermediate whites with arching spikes. These plants will have a degree of warmth tolerance.

Standards:

Beach Girl 'Geyserland' X Mem. Mark Henbury 'Geyserland' – Top quality standard oranges that will grow with ease and bloom profusely. This is a must have in a quality orchid collection.

Mem. Mark Henbury 'Geyserland' X (Karen X So Bold) #2 – Expect very tall spikes of high quality orange flowers that will be top quality show bench types. These plants will be very prolific and produce tons of spikes. Don't miss this one! March/April blooming.

Champagne Robin 'New Horizon' X Finger of Suspicion #1 – A true Ripper! Show bench spotted flowers. We expect these to be very special and very good growers! Awards! Blooming February – March.

[(Karen X So Bold) #1 X Keiko Kageyama 'Caramel'] – These will be very nice yellow – mustard color flowers, with bold red lips. Very tall flower spikes on reasonable sized plants. This will be a very floriferous plant! March flowering.

[(Karen X So Bold) #1 X Wattie's Hotpot 'Wolfie'] – A Standard yellow, of premium quality! A very good growing and rapid maturing plant. We made and selected this pod parent as it was truly a standout plant! Bloom in March.

Champagne Robin 'New Horizon' X Frank Kageyama 'Keiko' – Ignore this plant and you will sorry! Second generation George Formby hybrid – WOW! The pollen plant was past Grand Champion at the Santa Barbara International Show 2006. Spots galore, easy to grow fast maturing standard plant. We expect a light pink flower with tons of spots. .

Paul Robeson #1 x (James Wattie X Mighty Sensation) 'Wolfie' – Mid season standard red that should be large, round and with a bold lip! Awards.

Gloria Streeter 'North Shore' HCC/AOS x Mae West 'Geyserland' B/CSA – Early / Mid season Orange standard of extremely high quality! These will be good growing plants of top quality.

Paul Robeson '#1' x Finger of Suspicion 'Hatfields' – Mid season standard bred for very large flowers with intense red blotches. These should be very nice!

Bill Guest 'Hatfields' x Finger of Suspicion 'Hatfields' – Mid season standard bred for intense red blotches on a white base flower. We expect awards from this.

Paul Robeson '#1' x Harriet Ishitani '#4' – Unbelievable! Show bench red spotted flowers. We expect huge flowers upto 6" across from this cross! They will be very special and very good growers! Awards! Blooming February – March.

Doulass Dillon 'Hatfield's' HCC/AOS x Lena Bauer 'Hatfields' – These will be excellent bright pink Standards! Large flowers upto 5 inches across. Very good growers and truly top quality show plants will come from this cross. Blooming January - February.

[Karen Hawaiian 'Hatfields' x (Karen X So Bold) #1] – A Standard Orange of premium quality! A very good growing plant rapid to mature blooming size. We made and selected this pollen parent as it was truly a standout plant! Bloom in March.

Magic Passion 'Rowes' X Champagne Robin 'New Horizon' – We have very high expectations for this cross! Everything with Champagne Robin has turned out to be good! Show bench plants that will be pink and very round and full form. Some spotting possible here. Plants will bloom in Mid season.

Doulass Dillon 'Hatfield's' HCC/AOS x Bill Guest 'Hatfields' – These will be excellent red - bright pink Standards! Large flowers up to 5 inches across. Exceptionally tall upright flower spikes up to 4 feet tall with 19 – 21 flowers. Very good growers and truly top quality show plants will come from this cross. Blooming January - February.

Sleeping Beauty 'Vivid' 4n x Cym. lowianum 'Compte de Hemptine' 4n – Awesome standard greens with a dark banded lip. Very long spikes that should be very beautiful. Very late bloomers that will end your flowering season with a smile!
