between 26th and 28th Avenues.

Program: Our program this month will feature our own Weegie Caughlan addressing the state of US Cymbidium breeding of Standards as compared to the Australia breeding. The US has fallen way behind in this area and for many reasons it will be up to the serious hobbyist growers to try to halt the slide. See how the members of GCCG can help.

Weegie needs no introduction as one of the founding members of the GCCG and GGCS CSA Branches, multiple terms as President of GCCG, MOS and one term as President of POS. She is currently a senior AOS judge and accredited CSA judge. She has won numerous AOS and CSA awards for her plants, many of them her own crosses, multiple Best in local shows and awards for her displays. She has taken Grand Champion at the prestigious Santa Barbara International Orchid show four times and Reserve Champion five times. She lives in Los Altos Hills, CA with two rescued Champion Great Danes, about 2,000 Cymbidiums, and various other cool growing genera. During the growing season, the plants are outside on raised benches under oak trees. Weegie has been seriously growing Cymbidiums for over 45 years, although her first introduction was as a teenager taking care of her mother's orchids.

Plant Table: Weegie will supply the plant table from her extensive collection. There will be divisions of awarded plants as well as many new seedlings, a few from Australia. There should be something exciting for everyone.

- Supplies for sale at the September meeting: Unprinted labels, single-edged razor blades, pens, Twist Ties, pots of assorted sizes, 3' and 4' bamboo stakes, MSU (Romeo blend fertilizer), 1lb & 2lb jars, and dual virus testing kits are for sale at cost plus tax. Call ahead to the Chair of Ways and Means to see if we have gotten in the Orchiata bark (Precision, Classic, Power and Power+). (As of this printing, we are totally out.)
- Plant Sales Begin at 7 PM: Each member bringing in plants to sell will be solely responsible for selling their own plants at the table with no lists or percentage going to the club. Each seller will take home 100% of their sales proceeds and is responsible for reporting their own sales tax to the State. Since each member will be selling separately, buyers should be sure to bring sufficient change for all transactions. Each buyer will need to buy separately from each seller and will not be able to make one check covering all purchases. As in the past, all plants brought for sale by members must be properly labeled, priced (preferably in even dollar amounts) and free of disease. Sale rules for our annual April sale remain the same as before.
- Time to order Freeze Cloth: It is time to order freeze cloth (weight for 6-8 degree protection) for the coming winter at the October meeting for delivery at the November meeting. However, the smallest roll available is 500' in length and it will be necessary to have at least an initial order of 200' to justify the club ordering the large roll. The cloth is 12' wide and will be cut in 20' lengths, or longer/shorter if specially required. Minimum length order is 10'. The cost per running foot has been approximately \$1/ft in the past, but a slight increase is expected. To order, call Trudy Hadler at 510-483-1277 or order from her at the supply sales table at the October meeting.
- Auction Planning Time: Now is the time to think about the GCCG annual fund-raising auction to be held January 19, 2018. Please set aside a plant or two to donate to the club for the auction. Members may also sell up to ten of their own plants at the auction. For your sale plants that are auctioned, the club will retain 25% of the proceeds. PLEASE keep your club in mind and save some of those special plants for this event. This year, it is hoped all plants will be tested for virus as they were last year. An auction entry list is included in this month's Newsletter. Duplicate as needed. Complete information on the auction will be published in November as there is not a December Newsletter. A pdf form is attached in this Newsletter. Both a pdf and a Word form will be attached in November.

Plant Judging: The CSA judges Cymbidiums, Paphiopedilums, and Phragmipediums at our regular monthly meeting on the third Friday of each month September through May, or at the Lakeside Garden Center in Oakland on the fourth Wednesday of each month except November and December, when it is on the third Wednesday. To have a plant judged at GCCG, contact goldcoastcymgrowers@gmail.com at least one day in advance, to ensure that the CSA judges can be notified that plants will be submitted for judging. Plant entry is between 7:00 PM and 7:15 PM at the GCCG meeting and between 6:30 PM and 7:00 PM in Oakland. Clerks can advise you in filling out the plant entry form on your arrival.

The AOS judges all genera of orchids in San Francisco at the SF County Fair Building (Hall of Flowers) in Golden Gate Park on the first Tuesday, and at various other locations each month. For these judgings, plants need to be submitted between 6:15 PM and 7:00 PM. For further information and other judging locations, call Sylvia Darr 650-450-1384.

CSA and/or AOS judging takes place at most of the local shows. Contact the show organizers for specifics regarding plant entry for judging.
