Time: 7:00 PM (Auction plants may be checked in after 4:30 PM and until 6:00 PM)
Auction preview from 6:30 PM to 7:00 PM. Auction starts at 7:00 PM.

Place: The San Mateo Garden Center, 605 Parkside Way, San Mateo

Take the Alameda de las Pulgas exit off Highway 92. Turn south. The Garden Center is located between 26th and 28th Avenues.

Program: The program this month will consist of our annual Gold Coast Cymbidium Growers (GCCG) Collectors' Auction of Cymbidiums, Cymbidium Companion plants, and related orchid-growing materials. This is an extremely important fund-raising event for GCCG, since a large part of our yearly income depends on its success. We are very fortunate to again have as our auctioneer this year our famous "keep your paddle in the air" Jeff Trimble: Cymbidium Society of America (CSA) judge, GCCG past president and former CSA President.

Dinner with the Speaker, **Plant Table and Plant Sales:** These regularly scheduled events will not be held at this month's meeting due to the auction. Only those plants entered in the auction catalog, or preapproved as substitutes, will be allowed in the building.

Refreshments for the Auction: Refreshments are more than welcome at the auction. There will be no raffle this month, so remember to pick up your free raffle tickets at the <u>February</u> meeting! <u>Please</u> ensure that all items are labeled with the name of the provider so that Tony can record the names for the next newsletter and provide the 5 free raffle tickets prior to the February draw.

2018 AUCTION CONDUCT RULES: The rules for this year's auction, implemented to keep the auction under control and allow participants to go home at a reasonable time are listed at the beginning of the Auction Catalog. There are three ways for you to contribute to the success of this event - as a seller, donor and/or buyer:

Seller: Members have pre-submitted plants or related orchid items for sale, with 25% of the sale price benefiting GCCG and 75% going to the seller.

Donor: The Gold Coast Cymbidium Growers club thanks all those who have made donations to this year's auction to ensure the continued success of our organization.

Buyer: As an auction buyer you win in two ways. First, you add one or more quality plants to your collection. Second, you have the satisfaction in knowing that a portion of your winning bid that goes to Gold Coast will help support your club. 2018 Auction Rules:

- 1) **Only members may enter sale plants.** For the member sale plants that are auctioned, the club retains 25% of the proceeds, and the member receives the remaining 75%.
- 2) All plants entered for sale must be owned and grown by the seller for a minimum of 6 months.
- 3) DONATED plants will be accepted from members and non-members.
- 4) All plants must be pre-entered by December 15, 2017, complete with all known information.
- 5) Auction entries will be limited to 150 items/plants, except that all entries from the same seller / donor included in the same plant submission as the 150th plant will be accepted.
- 6) No entries will be accepted after the limit or deadline has been reached, whichever occurs first.
- 7) A member may enter no more than 10 plants for sale.
- 8) A limit of 10 plants per donor is requested.
- 9) It is suggested that all sellers consider donating at least 1-2 plants when entering 10 plants for sale.
- 10) In order to provide more selection, no more than two divisions of any one cultivar will be allowed in the auction. If more than two divisions are received by the coordinator, the first two received will be entered; sellers/donors will be notified if their submission has exceeded the limit.
- 11) No plants will be allowed into the building the night of the auction unless pre-entered or as a preapproved substitute for one damaged. A substitution will be granted only if rule 10 is not violated.
- 12) If a plant carrying a minimum bid does not sell at the declared minimum bid, said plant will be subject to reverse bidding until successfully auctioned.
- 13) Plants must be healthy, well established, and disease free or they will be withdrawn from the auction prior to the start of bidding at the owners' or club's discretion.
- 14) Bidders may not check out until the last item is auctioned and the auction concluded. Receipts to bidders will include a printout of their successful bids.

The CSA is the parent organization of the GCCG and not only provides liability insurance for GCCG events but allows us to operate under the umbrella of their 501(c)(3) tax status. Dues are \$35.00 per year, which includes a digital subscription to the CSA Journal, and should be mailed to Stanley Fuelscher, Cymbidium Society of America, 5710 Hollister Ave., #270; Goleta, CA 93117 or handed to Stanley at one of our meetings. Membership payment may also be made through PayPal on the CSA website. NOTE: The CSA Journal is going digital. Issues will only be available online.
- GCCG Show: The Show Chair for our April GCCG show is Sylvia Darr, with Florence Inserto as Sales Chair. This year we will again be at The Community Activities Building, 1400 Roosevelt Ave., Redwood City, CA. The show will be open to the public on Saturday, April 21st and Sunday April 22rd from 10 AM to 4 PM, and will include member plant sales both days. In addition to ribbon judging, we will have CSA and AOS judging. More information will be published in the February, March, and April Newsletters as plans and more committees are confirmed. Meanwhile, now is the time to offer your help to the show committee in any way you can by signing up for a job. Remember that every helping hand will make the show and sale even more successful!


Bob Harris Using Warm-Tolerant Cymbidiums in Hybridizing to Extend the Growing Season and Regions Where Cymbidiums Can Be Grown

Bob Harris and Jennifer Snyder, proprietors of OrchidPeople on the Big Island of Hawaii, have been growing and breeding cymbidiums since the late 1970s. Bob will report on their progress in creating warm growing cymbidiums with good-size flowers, high color, and compact leaves.

Graham will discuss the changes that have taken place in Maudiae style breeding in the last 30 years and what he hopes to achieve next.

Randall, a frequent speaker at the Congress, will lead an activity session examining ploidy levels in cymbidiums by determining ploidy through direct and indirect means; and assessing the distribution of color within a cymbidium flower, to better understand the potential for breeding for specific colors.
