Program: Our speaker this is month Kevin Hill speaking on “**A Survey of Non-Standard Cymbidiums**”.

The presentation will be a complement to Weegie’s October 2017 presentation on Standard Cymbidiums. More specifically a discussion of different types of non-Standard Cymbidium hybridizing programs that result in flower conformations different from what one expects from Standard Cymbidiums, and examples of non-Standard Cymbidiums that have received flower quality awards.

Kevin is an accredited judge with the American Orchid Society, California Sierra Nevada Judging Center, and has been growing Cymbidiums since 1995. He has a PhD in genetics, and works as a biotechnology patent examiner at the U.S. Patent and Trademark Office. His perspective on evaluating orchids is strongly influenced by his scientific background in developmental biology and genetics. He finds thinking about the genetic basis for controlling color patterns and shapes of the petals, sepals and lips of orchid flowers to be a fascinating challenge.

GCCG Sale: The deadline is April 7th, 2018 for all members wishing to sell plants at our show. Please email the Sales Chair, Florence Inserto at flojo1337@yahoo.com to reserve a table. If the tables are not filled by the deadline and a member would like a second table, they will be notified after the deadline. Each member must donate one plant to the raffle for each table requested. **All members reserving a table must enter plants (2 minimum) in the show. If two sales tables are requested, the member must put in a display.** There will be a table for members who wish to sell 5 or fewer plants. Since this is a two-day sale, sellers are asked to volunteer at least 1 hour each day.

44th Annual Cymbidium Congress: In conjunction with the Santa Barbara Orchid Show “**Orchid Mystique**” being held March 9th through March 11th, the CSA Congress will be held on March 10th, starting with the CSA Annual meeting at 8:30 AM followed by lectures, a luncheon, a panel discussion and the awards dinner banquet. The speakers for this year will be Cymbidium speakers Dr. Randall Robinson from Victoria University, Australia; Bob Harris of The Orchidpeople, Hawaii; and David Gynn of Sequoia Orchids, New South Wales, Australia. The Paphiopedilum speakers will be Harold Koopowitz of California and Graham Wood. The banquet speaker will be AOS President George Hatfield. A registration form is included in this month’s Newsletter. **Again this year, GCCG will be reimbursing the Congress fee to any member who attends the full Congress events for the first time.**

2018 Auction Wrap-Up: 2018 Auction Wrap-Up: Going .. Going.... Gone!!! We had another incredible auction this year! . There was excitement flowing in the air from the moment setup began to the second the last orchid was packed in the new owner's car. During this big event, 124 lots were sold in 1 hour and 30 minutes. 16 bidders brought in a total gross of \$4,400, for an average of \$35.48 per entry. The final net proceeds to the club treasury were \$2,453.75. Lot presenting and bidding overseen by Weegie Caughlan and "keep your paddle up" Jeff Trimble" was fast and furious for each orchid. This was especially true for the top 3 items sold: Lot 120, Cym. Tower of Fire 'Sunset Flame' for \$160; Lot 122, Cym. *tracyanum* v. album 'Woodside' for \$130; and Lot 123, another Cym. *tracyanum* v. album 'Woodside', for \$130.

Kudos go out to our top 3 donors who donated 10 plants each: Weegie Caughlan with \$322, Darrel Wong with \$289 and Pierre Pujol with \$216.

An auction of this high a caliber is always a result from hundreds of hours of work entering plants, virus testing, researching and editing the catalog text, and finding photos or links for as many of the lot entries as possible. Hundreds of hours of time are needed to support this auction and to make it something unique and special and as a result it has become a real roll model for other clubs. Thank you for your support!

The AOS judges all genera of orchids in San Francisco at the SF County Fair Building (Hall of Flowers) in Golden Gate Park on the first Tuesday and in Oakland at the Lakeside Garden Center on the third Monday, of each month. For either judging, plants need to be submitted to the clerks between 6:15PM and 7:00PM. CSA and/or AOS judging takes place at most of the local shows. Contact the show organizers for specifics regarding plant entry for judging.

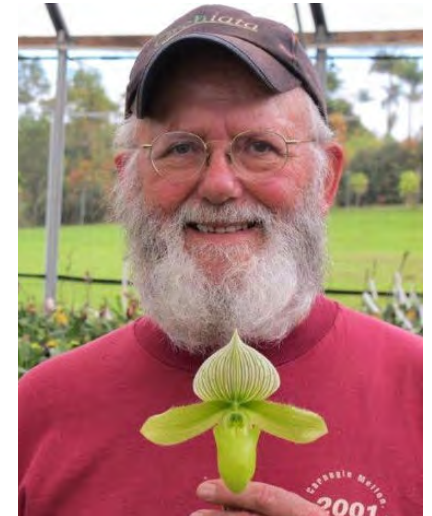
Harold Koopowitz
